- Be able to integrate Scripture with both teaching and scholarship
- Have strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Be an evangelical Christian and agree with Cedarville University's doctrinal statement, community covenant, and general workplace Standards

- Be visionary, innovative, results-oriented, and passionate about business and the ideals of Christian higher education
- Have a record of progressive and significant leadership, preferably in a higher education setting
- Have significant relevant professional business experience
