Description: The School of Business at Charleston Southern University invites applications for two open positions at the rank of Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Business Administration. Primary needs are in the areas of accountancy and management, however, candidates in one of the other functional areas of business will be considered.

Qualifications: An earned doctorate in a field of business is required. Prior teaching experience and demonstrated effectiveness in undergraduate and graduate instruction is preferred.

Responsibilities: The teaching load will include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in a traditional format as well as graduate courses in an online format. Faculty members are also called upon to participate in academic advising, serve on committees, and engage in service and scholarly activities. The successful candidate will be committed to integrating the Christian faith into his or her teaching and writing, and advancing the Christian mission of the University.
