The Department of Economics and Business is seeking an Assistant or Associate Professor of Finance. Successful candidates must be committed to excellence in the integration of Christian faith, and the highest standards of teaching, in the field of finance.

This position is a tenure-track position to begin August 1, 2010. Preference will be given to candidates with a doctorate completed by the time of appointment. Candidates with relevant financial sector experience, an M.B.A. or M.S. in Finance, and appropriate certification (C.F.A. or C.F.P.) will also be considered.

The faculty member in this position will be expected to teach courses from among such topics as financial management, financial markets and institutions, advanced corporate finance, investment analysis, or other finance- and business-related courses. The faculty member in this position also serves as the primary advisor to the Department's finance majors, many of whom take the C.F.A. Level 1 exam shortly after graduation.
