The Department of Economics and Business is seeking an Assistant or Associate Professor of Economics. Successful candidates must be committed to excellence in the integration of Christian faith and the highest standards of teaching in the field of economics. This position is a tenure-track position to begin January 1, 2008 or August 1, 2008 depending on the candidate's availability. Preference will be given to candidates with a doctorate completed by the time of appointment.

The faculty member in this position will be expected to teach courses in principles of microeconomics, intermediate microeconomics, and selected upper-level elective courses in microeconomics-oriented topics such as game theory, public finance, labor economics, or environmental economics. The faculty member will also be expected to participate in the College's seminar program for first-year students.
