



## **Program Director/Faculty Member Management Practice Master's Degree Program**

Greenville College is seeking a dynamic, entrepreneurial faculty member to lead a nascent master's degree program in management. This 33-credit program is based on a widely-adopted European model for advanced management study for working professionals. The program, which started in the fall of 2010, currently has more than 30 students enrolled. We anticipate that that number will more than double during the 2011-12 academic year.

The successful candidate will demonstrate commitment to professional education in a liberal arts context, hold an earned doctorate from a regionally-accredited university in business administration, economics, or related field, and have a vibrant personal Christian faith commitment. Candidates must demonstrate administrative skill, have a record of increasing responsibility in their careers, and be dedicated working in a Christian academic community. Because the program is a hybrid of online and face-to-face instruction, the successful candidate should have online teaching experience.

Rank is open, but we expect that the successful candidate will be appointed at the associate or full professor level. The start date is July 1, 2010. This is a 12-month appointment in the Management Department.

**Responsibilities:** Primary responsibilities include providing oversight of and instruction in the MS in Management Practice Program on the main campus in Greenville, Illinois, and possibly at various off-campus classroom locations within a 100-mile radius. The candidate will likely teach one or more courses in Greenville College's traditional undergraduate program. The specific course assignments will depend on the candidate's education and experience.

**Compensation:** Salary is based on academic background and experience. The College also provides a generous benefits package that includes health, retirement, life insurance, and disability plans, as well as tuition waiver for dependents at Greenville and a tuition exchange program with 80+ other Christian colleges.

**School of Professional Studies:** One of three schools at Greenville College, the school of Professional Studies is the home to four departments: Management, Organizational Leadership, Digital Media, and Health, Recreation and Physical Education.

**Greenville College:** The College is a Christian liberal arts college with 1100 traditional undergraduates, 200 adult students, and 350 graduate students. We are located 50 miles east of St. Louis in an attractive residential community of approximately 8,000 people. Greenville was founded in 1892 and has a rich heritage of affiliation with the Free Methodist Church, yet draws students from 40+ denominations.

**Applications:** Application materials should include a (1) letter of application, (2) curriculum vitae, (3) statement of philosophy of Christian higher education, (4) statement of personal faith journey and commitment, (5) letters from three references, and (6) official transcripts.
