

## **Position Summary**

Houston Baptist University seeks a full-time faculty member in Finance with the ability to teach undergraduate and MBA level finance courses, with specialized courses in corporate finance, investments, financial markets and institutions, and financial derivatives (note: position pending funding). Rank will be commensurate with qualifications. Candidates should be available to begin work in the fall, 2009. Review of applications will begin by Dec. 1, 2008, and continue until position is filled.

## **Education**

Candidates must hold an earned PhD by August 2009, demonstrate a record of quality teaching and research in their field and have adequate skills in the use of instructional technology. They must be willing to participate in department and university activities and be committed to the vision and mission of HBU as articulated in the Ten Pillars ([www.hbu.edu/TenPillars](http://www.hbu.edu/TenPillars)), which guides the university's HBU 2020 program.
