### **Business/Fall 2008:**

Due to recent and anticipated growth, the Division of Business is looking to fill a full-time faculty member position. This position will remain open until filled. The Division of Business offers six degrees –Accounting, Business Administration, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Management, and Marketing. The position requires the faculty member to teach sections of entry-level Foundations of Business course to freshmen, as well as teach other upper- and lower-level core business courses depending on the area of expertise. The position requires university service, curriculum development and design, scholarly activity, and academic advisement. A doctorate in a business-related area is required. ABD's near completion will be considered. All candidates should have substantial work experience, experience teaching at the college level, and a strong Christian commitment. This person should be supportive of theology in the Wesleyan-Arminian tradition.
