POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Indiana Wesleyan University seeks a creative and engaging leader of strong academic reputation in both teaching and scholarship to serve as the Associate Dean of the School of Social and Behavioral Sciences and Business in the College of Arts and Sciences. As a member of the College of Arts and Sciences Academic Leadership Council, the Associate Dean reports directly to the Vice President and Dean for the College of Arts and Sciences and carries responsibility for academic programs, assessment, faculty, and academic budgets.

Providing a liberal education for residential students, the College of Arts and Sciences enrolls 2800 students. One of six schools within the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Social and Behavioral Sciences and Business is comprised of five divisions: behavioral sciences, business, graduate counseling, leadership studies, and social sciences.
