Position: Assistant Professor of Management Studies

Summary:

The Department of Management Studies seeks an eleven month tenure track faculty member. The position will begin Fall, 2012.

Role:

- Delivery of online and in-class (ground) classroom instruction in the program(s).
- Successful candidate will teach courses relative to accounting: Management Controls (Accounting), Finance Management, and Research and Statistical Methods.
- The candidate might also be a facilitator, overseeing the Integrated Research Project (IRP) for undergraduate degree completion students. The premise of the specific courses is to prepare students for work in the field of management and or accounting.
- Effective interpersonal skill, problem-solving, critical and creative thinking, business ethics, and Christian values are emphasized.

Qualifications:

- Doctoral qualifications (PhD in accounting; DBA with accounting emphasis preferred). Also considered CPA, MBA and or JD with professional experience.
- Practical managerial experience.
- Experience with online and ground classroom teaching.
- Experience and strong commitment to teaching excellence with the adult learner, professional development, and scholarly research.
- Commitment to the Christian faith and the university's mission, foundational principles, and educational goals.
- Commitment to faith and learning in the academic discipline.

The Malone Management Program is an accelerated bachelor's degree completion program for students. The program was founded in 1984, and is the oldest and longest running degree completion program in northeast Ohio.
