DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

Northwest Nazarene University is seeking applications for a position in Global Business/Leadership to begin in the fall, 2010. The candidates should have competence in Global Business/Leadership. Teaching assignments may include daytime and evening courses at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Final decisions about teaching assignment will depend on need in this growing program. The position may entail some administrative responsibilities in a new PhD program.

QUALIFICATIONS

Preferred candidates will have a Ph.D., DBA or be ABD in a regionally accredited program in Global Business/Leadership or related field. The successful candidate should have a record of scholarship or a willingness to begin engaging in scholarly activity. The university requires that all candidates have a Christian perspective (preferably in the Wesleyan tradition), and must be comfortable with and in agreement with the mission and lifestyle values of NNU. Qualified minorities are encouraged to apply.

COMPENSATION

The salary will be determined by the educational background and experience of each applicant. Full-time faculty will be offered a benefits package including health insurance for faculty and family, vision and dental for employee, life and disability insurance, opportunities for faculty development, sabbatical experiences, and a retirement program.
