The successful candidate will oversee the launch of a new Master's in Accounting degree program and teach in the program as well as in the existing undergraduate -business major. Course assignments will primarily be in accounting but may also include instruction in other business areas such as finance and economics. Additional responsibilities include on-campus community involvement, student advising, spiritual mentoring, community service, academic research and other duties traditionally associated tenure track faculty positions. Business is one of TIU's largest undergraduate majors and Accounting is one of the program's most successful -emphases, with graduates demonstrating a high pass-rate on the CPA exam.

Candidates for this position must have recent and relevant work experience in accounting, possess a CPA and hold an earned doctorate in a business.
