The Business and Economics Department of Wheaton College (IL) invites applicants for two tenure-track positions to begin August, 2012. A Ph.D. (or DBA) in an applied business field, such as Finance or Management, is required:

- 1) **ASSISTANT PROFESSOR in BUSINESS.** Teaching responsibilities include introductory required courses, as well as upper-division elective courses. Experience in enterprise and/or international business is desirable.

- 2) **ASSOCIATE/FULL PROFESSOR in BUSINESS.** Candidates should have an established research record, as well as proven excellence in teaching. The Chair has a research budget and a teaching load of 16 hours per year. Teaching responsibilities include introductory required courses, as well as upper-division elective courses. Experience in enterprise and/or international business is desirable. Candidates should be able to assume a position of general influence on the campus and in the larger community, promoting the integration of commitment to Christ, biblical values, and sound business practices.

Candidates should have a strong commitment to the liberal arts and integrating Christian values into their teaching. Wheaton College is an evangelical Protestant Christian liberal arts college whose faculty are all evangelical Protestant Christians who affirm a Statement of Faith and adhere to lifestyle expectations.
