



**Reviewing Criteria for
2021 Annual CBFA Conference
Theme: Intersection of Faith & Business**

Responses to all criteria are indicated using level-of-agreement statements with 5-point Likert scales where 1=strongly disagree, 2=disagree, 3=neutral, 4=agree, and 5=strongly agree. Reviewing criteria in use are as follows:

- This submission fits the 2021 conference theme (10% weight)
- This submission contributes to CBFA and greater scholarship (20% weight)
- This submission shows knowledge of the topic and/or current state of the field, as identified within the manuscript (20% weight)
- This submission demonstrates appropriate rigor (20% weight)
- This submission integrates scholarship and/or pedagogy with issues of faith (20% weight)
- This submission is clearly written (10% weight)

All regular submissions are randomly assigned to three volunteer reviewers based on self-reported expertise. We use a blind review process. There is a new process for panels this year. These proposals will be evaluated for general interest by all volunteer reviewers after which the CBFA board will select which submissions are assigned to the academic program.
